

# Teacher Portfolio Template

- The Portfolio process for SY2015-16 has changed in response to feedback from teachers and administrators
  - Only two required components: one School Wide Component and one Choice Component.
  - Limits on size/length of Portfolio presentation: no more than 5 slides for the PowerPoint and 3 artifacts per component.
- Use the slides below as a guide the focus of the 5 slides.
- Note that the “Rationale” slide is optional and teachers may elect to use only 4 slides, or to replace the “Rationale” slide with something of their own choosing.

# How to use this Template

- View the template in “Normal” or “Notes Page” view so that you will be able to read the notes below each of the Template slides.
- You can change the view by clicking on the “VIEW” tab, far to the right of the “FILE” tab.
- Save your completed Portfolio Presentation to your laptop, along with a maximum of 6 artifacts that provide evidence for your performance on the two required components.
- Also save the Portfolio Presentation and artifacts to BriteLocker.

# School Wide Component: (e.g, 1a)

- Artifacts that will be presented include
  - (Insert description—i.e., a lesson plan for ELA focused on important writing concepts).
